The Comprehensive Research and Digitization Project on Subjects of East Asian Paintings is a Korea-based project that aims to collect, discover, and interpret the subjects of East Asian paintings and to establish a comprehensive database, based on this information. In this presentation, the speaker will introduce this wide-ranging project and discuss methods by which painting categories can be classified through an examination of art historical definitions, literary sources, historical trends, and other factors. It is hoped that the research materials gained from this project will be incorporated into a web-based database system that will not only provide basic information about East Asian paintings but also connect painting subjects with the relevant literary records.
